Don't Ignore Warnings

If you discover you have a fault light or engine light code on it's telling you something is not right, so don't ignore it. Book your vehicle in and an appropriate scan tool is plugged into your vehicle computer (ECU). It provides information to the technician about the possible and likely causes of the fault lights. The technician will advise you about what is wrong and how it can be fixed. Sometimes these faults can be difficult to fix so it's important you get the right people on the job with the right equipment.
